Titration is an analytical method used to determine the exact amount of a substance by reacting that substance with a known amount of another substance. The completed reaction of a titration is usually indicated by a color change or an electrical measurement. An acid/base neutralization reaction will yield salt and water.

Acid-Base Titration A titration is a process used to determine the volume of a solution that is needed to react with a given amount of another substance. In this experiment, your goal is to determine the molar concentration of two acid solutions by conducting titrations with a base of known concentration.

The purpose of the titration is the detection of the equivalence point, the point at which chemically equivalent amounts of the reactants have been mixed. The amount of reactants that have been mixed at the equivalence point depends on the stoichiometry of the reaction.

PRE-LAB DISCUSSION: In the chemistry laboratory, it is sometimes necessary to experimentally determine the concentration of an acid solution or a base solution. A procedure for making this kind of determination is called an ACID-BASE TITRATION.

the process is called the equivalence point of a titration. We can monitor the progress of acid-base titrations by two means. The first uses a pH meter, and the second uses an acid-base indicator. An indicator is a dye that has the particular property of changing color as a function of pH.
